



Healthy Families America Timeline

1972: Donna Stone founds PCA America.

1976: First state chapter formed in Kansas.

1979: First national evaluation of child abuse prevention programs.

1986: National Center on Child abuse Prevention Research established.

1992: Healthy Families America is launched in partnership with RMHC and Hawaii Healthy Start.

1995: 1-800-Children established to increase public awareness about child abuse prevention.

1996: First HFA state leaders meeting convened & Credentialing standards developed.

2000: PCA America & National Family Support Roundtable launch network of family support and mutual self-help programs.

2002: HFA flourishes in over 450 communities in 38 states, DC and Canada.
