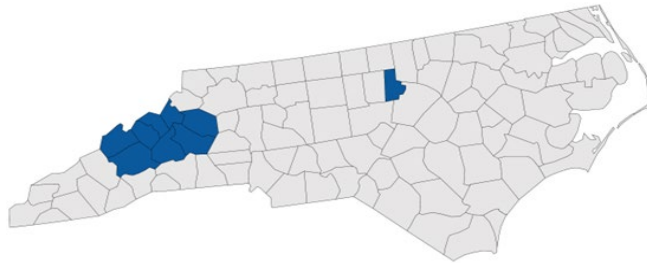


North Carolina

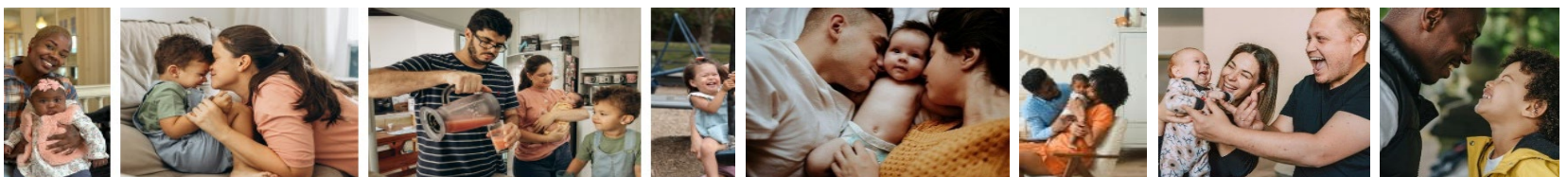
