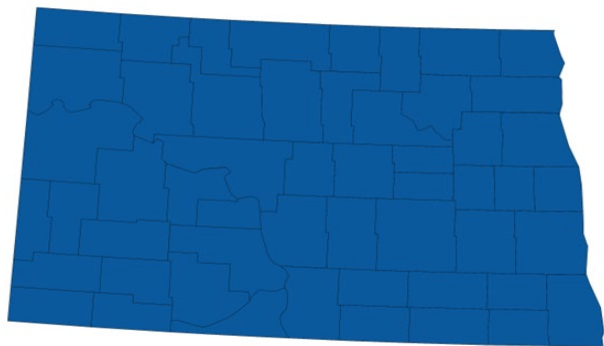


North Dakota

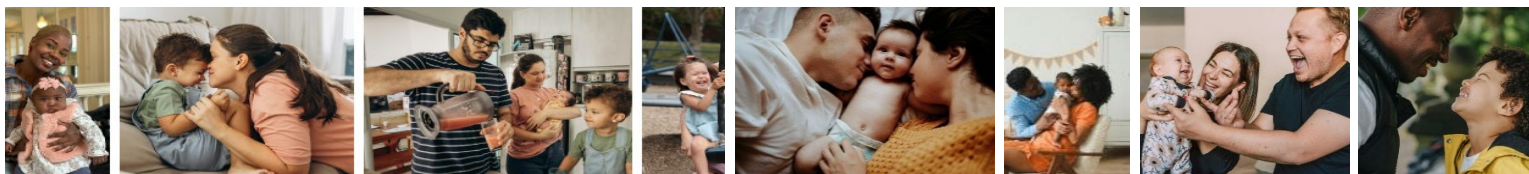
